ABRIA PREGNANCY RESOURCES – PRAYER CHAPEL

For we are not contending against flesh and blood, but against the principalities, against the powers, against the world rulers of this present darkness, against the spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. Thank you for your interest in supporting Abria in the spiritual battle. The battle is real, and Abria is engaged on the front lines. Knowing that, our founders and leaders built a chapel on site. Our archdiocese supports monthly masses in the chapel. The Blessed Sacrament is continuously reposed.

WE NEED PRAYERS

It is our goal to have at least one volunteer in prayer in our chapel - praying for Abria's mission, our clients, staff and volunteers - every hour our clinics are open. Our current hours are M-F, 9 A.M. to 4 P.M., Saturday, 9 A.M. to 1 P.M.

ORIENTATION NOTES

- **Prayer** (not Eucharistic Adoration) – We are asking for your commitment to be part of the “armor of God” in our daily spiritual battle, at Abria’s St Paul chapel. Pray for our mission, clients, staff and volunteers. The Blessed sacrament is always reposed, not exposed as in a Eucharistic Adoration chapel. But He is here!
(We are using the web service “We Adore Him” to help coordinate our schedule. There may be some disconnect in the default site language. We appreciate your understanding.)
- **Commitment** – Sign up for a weekly commitment, a bi-weekly commitment, or a single hour. Ideally we would have all hours covered by a weekly Prayer, but know that any commitment is appreciated. Consider sharing a weekly hour with a friend if you are not able to make it every week.
- **Registration, Sign-In, Changes** – Follow the instructions on the site (<https://abria.weadorehim.com/en>) to register, sign-in, and make changes when necessary.
- **Substitutes** – There is a tool in the “We Adore Him” software to facilitate finding substitutes when someone is unable to make their committed hour. This tool is

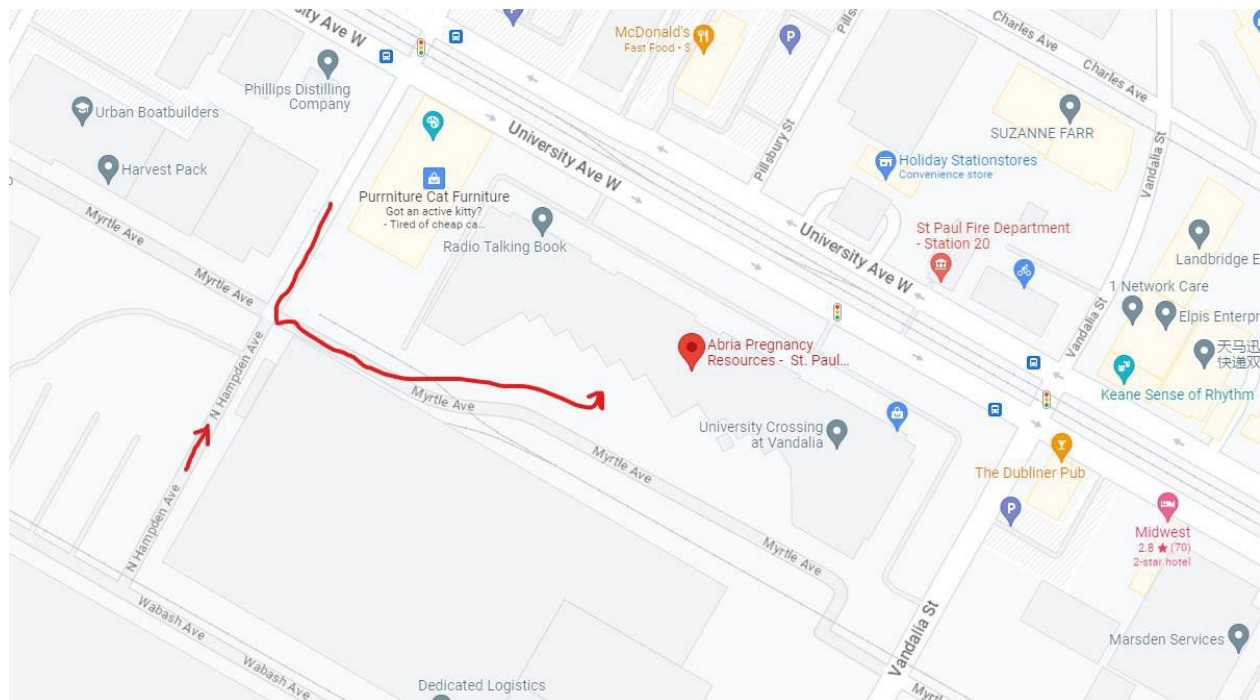
especially important for Eucharistic Adoration sites. While subs are not required at the Abria Prayer Chapel (because the Blessed Sacrament is not exposed), it is ideal to have every hour of our schedule covered. If you can be a sub, consider signing up in that section of the tool.

- **Access, Arrival and Checking In** – In order to keep the main entry area free for our clients, the Abria Prayer Chapel can be accessed through our backdoor. **See the following page for a map and instructions for access.** Upon arrival, ring the doorbell. Staff will let you in. When you enter the chapel please check-in on the kiosk or the daily sign-in sheet.
- **Recruiting** – Do you know others who may be able to pray with us. Please spread the word.

Directions to Abria Pregnancy Clinic Chapel

Abria's St. Paul Clinic Address: **2200 University Avenue West #160 St. Paul, MN 55114**

Please enter Abria's Chapel by the clinic's **back entrance**. To access the back entrance, from University Avenue turn **SOUTH** on **N Hampden Ave** and turn **EAST** on **Myrtle Ave**. (Please note it may feel as if you are entering an industrial area)



Drive along side the building until you locate a divider that appears like the picture below. **Park** in the area denoted by the blue box.



Abria back entrance has a plaque next to it that has Abria's name and address. **Ring the doorbell** circled in blue in the picture below when you arrive!
