2001

The Highland Life Care Center (HLCC) opens in St. Paul's Highland neighborhood, just steps from Planned Parenthood.



The University Life Care Center (ULCC) opens near the University of Minnesota in Dinkytown as Minnesota's first pregnancy resource center under the Total Life Care (TLC) umbrella.



2012

ULCC and HLCC combine resources and work together to expand their reach to better serve women and families in the Twin Cities.



2018

Northside Pregnancy Options (est. 1978) joins Abria as our North Minneapolis clinic, featuring state-of-the-art facilities.



2025

Abria marks 50 years of service to thousands of women seeking a choice for life!



Maria's Story: A Legacy of Life and Love

My name is Maria, and it's been over 45 years since I first walked through the doors of what was then Northside Life Care Center—what you now know as, Abria. I was just 15, newly pregnant, and terrified. I remember the lump in my throat as

I told my mom. Instead of anger, she offered me love—and she brought me to Northside.

That first visit gave me more than a pregnancy test. It gave me hope. The staff there didn't see a statistic or a mistake. They saw me—a young girl in crisis who needed kindness, guidance, and support.

We welcomed a baby boy and named him Andrew. Shortly after, I married my high school sweetheart, and somehow we made

it through those early years. It wasn't easy. We were young, broke, and trying to raise a baby while still growing up ourselves. My oldest—now a grown man with a family of his own—was the first of seven kids. Andrew helped raise his siblings, showed a calm and steady strength even as a teenager. I look back and wonder how we did it all.

I'll tell you how: we didn't do it alone.

Abria was there. They gave me baby clothes. They helped with medical care. But most importantly, they reminded me that I was never alone.

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That's the heart of Abria's mission: to meet women where they are, without judgment, with compassion and practical help. They walk alongside you when the world feels like it's caving in. They don't just hand you diapers—they hold your heart.

Now, decades later, I see the ripple effects of that love. My children. My grandchildren. And so many other "Abria babies" who are

growing up, thriving, giving back to their communities. Because someone believed in their worth before they were even born.

Abria didn't just support me—they changed the course of my life. And I will always be grateful.



LOVE IN ACTION:

RESPONDING TO THE CHALLENGES WOMEN FACE

At Abria, we believe every woman deserves to be seen, heard, and supported—no matter the circumstances. The challenges are real, but so is the hope. In every obstacle, we see an opportunity to extend compassion, innovate our care, and invite the community to stand for life in powerful new ways.

The Rise of At-Home Abortions

In 2023, more than 14,000 women in Minnesota ended their pregnancies, a nearly 16% increase over 2022. Over 9,000 of these abortions were done through the abortion pill, often taken at home, in dorm rooms, bathrooms, or bedrooms— many without medical supervision.

Abria is committed to reaching her first—before fear, pressure, or isolation take over. Nearly 45% of our clients now find us through digital outreach, and another 33% come by personal referral. We're meeting women at the most critical moment: when they're searching for answers.

To navigate this new era, we're re-engaging key advisory groups, including our Medical Advisory
Team, and equipping clergy and our church partners through resources.
We also remind our church partners that 1 in 4 women in their pews has had an abortion—highlighting the opportunity for grace and healing.

When She's Ready, We're Ready

A woman facing an unexpected pregnancy doesn't plan ahead—she calls when the fear hits, when the pressure builds, or when she's just walked out of another clinic still searching for hope. Sometimes she walks in from Planned Parenthood down the street. Sometimes she's from the Northside, anxious and alone.

But in that moment, she needs someone to pick up. Someone to say, "We can see you now." And that's where we've felt the strain. Staffing shortages—whether nurses or client advocates—have stretched our team thin, putting our commitment to never turn a woman away at risk.

With 24/7 online scheduling already in place, women can book appointments the moment they're ready. And we're preparing to launch a live agent feature to ensure even more immediate, personal connection—especially in the hours when need is the highest.

To support in-clinic capacity, we're developing a volunteer-powered network of trained Client Advocates, ready to step in when staffing is tight. This approach will help us cover gaps, say "yes" more often, and expand our hours to meet growing demand.

Becoming Known, Building Trust: Abria in the Community

Even with two strategically located clinics, too many women and families in our city still don't know who we are—or what we offer. In neighborhoods like the Northside and across the Twin Cities, we regularly hear, "I wish I had known about you sooner." That gap in awareness delays care and leaves women vulnerable to abortion by default.

We're taking bold steps to change that. This year, we're re-engaging trusted community partners—from neighborhood groups to churches—ensuring Abria is more visible and accessible than ever. We're showing up at community events, school resource fairs, and grassroots gatherings to meet people where they are and make sure they know: we are here, and we are ready to help.

Our Young Adult Network is relaunching to reignite campus outreach. And we're preparing to launch training opportunities for pastors and church leaders, equipping them with tools to identify and compassionately support the 1 in 4 women in the pews who have experienced or are considering abortion.





HOW WE SERVE THE ABRIA EXPERIENCE

Digital Marketing

Abria's digital marketing helps connect us to women searching for her pregnancy options in her time of need.

FOCUS Program

As she contemplates her decision, our licensed registered nurse offers a labquality pregnancy test, an STI test, and a limited obstetrical ultrasound providing her with accurate medical information that she needs to understand her pregnancy options.

Follow-Up Protocol

Our accompaniment with women goes beyond her first appointment. We understand decision-making and processing for a woman with an unexpected pregnancy takes more a than one hour, and we

want to be with her in every step of the way

Our follow-up process is in place for all our clients that ensures she is seeing, hearing, and experiencing Abria as a friend and resource to her in this time of uncertainty.

Baby Is Born

Abria gives a baby shower in a basket for the mom and child!



Appointment Is Made

She clicks, calls or texts to make an appointment.

Community Resources

We connect women with organizations who specialize in services to help women gain access to affordable health insurance, identify low income housing, receive help in their employment search and many other needs they may have.

Empowers Program

Women who choose parenting are paired with a Client Advocate who provides one-on-one life coaching, individualized education sessions and connections to community resources.

As she participates in her education, she earns credits to shop in the Abria Boutique. This resource continues through the Equips program.



Graduation from Abria's Program

Clients participate in our programs until their child is two years old.

Equips Program

After the birth of her baby, a woman is invited to join a small group program with other women who have children of a similar age. They experience community, comradery and encouragement as they learn about parenting, nutrition, development, and much more.
